Join us to reconstruct a working Dean Goods Locomotive!

The Project Aims to faithfully reconstruct GWR Dean Goods locomotive number 2513 as a fully working loco incorporating serviceable original parts where available. To provide opportunities to pass on heritage engineering skills and operate a Dean era locomotive on heritage railways. The 2513 Project is a registered Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) – Registered Charity Number 1213776.

Location. The **West Somerset Railway** are generously hosting this project.

Why Do This? The story of GW motive power before the 20th century is poorly represented with little surviving from the Dean era or before. The 2513 proposal is for a “go anywhere” simply constructed locomotive of mid power and economical type, attractive for heritage lines and popular with GW enthusiasts. The existence of an available original boiler and relevant parts make this project a resurrection rather than a complete new build. Importantly no other locos will be compromised by the acquisition of original parts.

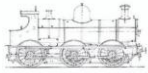
Progress to Autumn 2025

- Boiler no 1763 has been acquired through project supporters. This boiler was previously carried by 2513 and several other Dean Goods locos.
- Inspection and testing indicate that the boiler is suitable for future use
- Several important original reuseable parts have been acquired
- A significant number of reusable parts from several sources have been offered to the project for early acquisition
- Original GWR engineering drawings are being acquired
- The founders of the project bring many years of practical experience of GWR locomotives, the operation of heritage locomotive owning groups and the design and production of engineering parts using both traditional and modern techniques
